

Bill Reagan

The Training Arena is pleased to host “Top Gun QB Academy” founded by Bill Reagan in 2003. Bill’s love and passion for the quarterback position, coupled with his knowledge of passing mechanics and footwork are the perfect match for mentoring local junior and senior high quarterbacks during their off months. Currently, eleven schools are starting quarterbacks who have trained with Bill Reagan at Top Gun.

Bill Reagan is the Assistant Director for Athletics Advancement at the University of Notre Dame. Previously, Bill was the Director of Football Operations at Notre Dame under Coach Bob Davie and Coach Tyrone Willingham. Prior to Notre Dame, Bill spent six years as the Offensive Coordinator at Ashland (Ohio) University, and helped guide Ashland to the 1997 Midwest Intercollegiate Football Conference Championship as well as a NCAA Division II playoff berth. The Eagles were among the national leaders in total offense.



Most of Bill’s career was spent at his alma mater, St. Joseph’s College, where he was the Head Football Coach for ten years. His teams finished as championship runners-up three times. His offensive units, statistically finished in the top 5 of NCAA Division II in ’86, ’87, ’88 & ’89. At St. Joseph’s, he mentored the school’s all-time leading rusher, receiver and tackler, as well as the all-time leader in touchdowns and 4 all-conference QB’s. St. Joseph’s also delivered 4 All-Americans and 3 Academic All-Americans during his tenure as head coach. Bill served as defensive coordinator during his first three years coaching at St. Joseph’s.

Bill played QB at St. Joseph’s College and guided St. Joseph’s to the Indiana Collegiate Conference Championship for the first time in 14 years. He was voted to the Outstanding College Athletes of America, along with being named to the Indiana Collegiate Conference All-League Team. He also set career records at St. Joseph’s for: passing TDs, completion pct., passing yards as well as TD passes in one game.

Upon graduation from St. Joseph’s, Bill taught and coached in Boston for one year followed by Libby and Bowsher High Schools in Toledo, Ohio for six years.

Bill Reagan was inducted into St. Joseph’s College Athletics Hall of Fame as well as the Lorain County (Ohio) Hall of Fame in the spring of 2005.
